The MCS population

All children born between

1/11/2000 and 31/8/2001 (England and Wales)

23/11/2000 and 11/1/2002 (Scotland and Northern Ireland)

AND

alive and living in the UK at age 9 months, and eligible to receive
Child Benefit at that age



MCS7 Survey response rates (Number of families)

	<i>Total</i>	England	Wales	Scotland	Northern Ireland
Total eligible sample	14,467	9,422	2,035	1,638	1,374
Productive	10,625	7,124	1,415	1,105	981
Response rate	73.4%	75.6%	69.5%	67.5%	71.4%
