## **NCDS Data Note 7**

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

This *NCDS Data Note* reports on work done to improve the quality of the occupation data available for the fifth follow-up of the *National Child Development Study (NCDS5)*. It consolidates the considerable work done by Laurence Letchford (former NCDS DP Manager) and Peter Shepherd (SSRU) on this aspect of NCDS5 data, and was prepared by Peter Shepherd. It is hoped that the information provided below may be of value to others analysing NCDS data.

A brief introduction to NCDS will be followed by an account of the problems encountered in the original occupation data and their resolution. Revised occupation data are also provided.

## NATIONAL CHILD DEVELOPMENT STUDY

The *National Child Development Study (NCDS)* is a continuing, multi-disciplinary longitudinal study which takes as its subjects all those living in Great Britain who were born between 3 and 9 March, 1958.

Following the initial birth survey in 1958 - the *Perinatal Mortality Survey (PMS)* - there have been, to date, five attempts to trace all members of the birth cohort in order to monitor their physical, educational and social development. These were carried out by the National Children's Bureau in 1965 (*NCDS1*), 1969 (*NCDS2*), 1974 (*NCDS3*), and 1981 (*NCDS4*); and by the Social Statistics Research Unit, City University in 1991 (*NCDS5*). In addition, in 1978, details of public examination entry and performance were obtained from schools and colleges.

For the *PMS* information was obtained from the *mother* and from *medical records* by the midwife. For *NCDS1-3*, information was obtained from: *parents* (by health visitors); *head teachers* and *class teachers* (who completed questionnaires); *medical examination* (carried out by the schools health service); and the *subjects* themselves (who completed tests of ability and, latterly, questionnaires).

*NCDS4* differs in that information was obtained from the *subject* by survey research interviewer, and from the *1971 and 1981 Censuses* - from which variables describing area of residence were taken. Similarly, *NCDS5* also relied on survey research interviewers to collect information from *subjects*. Self-completion questionnaires were also used to gather data from *NCDS subjects* and from *husbands, wives, and cohabiters*. In addition, for a random sample of one in three subjects, information was collected for all *natural or adopted children* who were living with them. Data were gathered from the *children* themselves, and from their *mother, or mother-figure* (who might be the cohort member, or their spouse or partner), using a series of age-specific assessments of cognitive and behavioural development. These were supplemented by a *mother* interview, and by *interviewer observations* of mother-child interaction.

During *EXAMS* survey, information was obtained only from *schools and colleges* by postal survey.

In addition information has also been gathered during a number of *NCDS Special Sub-studies* for samples of cohort members selected for their particular characteristics. They include studies of children in care, adoptive children, gifted children, the children of one-parent families, handicapped school leavers, and those suffering from epilepsy, respiratory problems, and Crohn's disease.

### Data available for research

The data from the *NCDS* follow-ups are held by the ESRC Data Archive at the University of Essex and on-line at Manchester Computing. Access to the data is open to anyone interested, although intending users are asked to commit themselves to ensuring that confidentiality is observed, and to inform the *NCDS User Support Group* at the Centre for Longitudinal Studies about their proposed use of the data and any resulting publications, etc.

The Data Archive also hold data from a number of special sub-studies where additional data has been gathered for samples of cohort members selected for their special characteristics or circumstances.

### **User Group**

This is open to all users of NCDS data. It provides opportunities for users to get together to explore developments, problems, and other issues of mutual interest. Ad hoc "Updates" on NCDS data and developments are circulated to members.

Membership is free on application to the NCDS User Support Group.

### **User Support Group**

This provides advice and guidance on the use of NCDS data; produces documentation; collates and disseminates information on uses of the data, publications, and other developments; produces and distributes a newsletter and working papers; provides access to non-computerised NCDS data; collects additional information; and services the User Group.

## NCDS5 REVISED OCCUPATION DATA FOR CURRENT/LAST JOB

### Background

For funding reasons occupation information gathered during the NCDS5 survey was coded using **CASOC** (Computer-Assisted Standard Occupation Coding) software developed by the Institute of Employment Research at the University of Warwick. The textual descriptions of over 100,000 jobs held by cohort members and their partners were keyed to disk and coded using CASOC in fully-automatic mode - *ie*: without any operator intervention - generating 27 different codings per job - *ie*: 2.7 million codings.

Following a number of queries raised by SSRU-users about the CASOC occupation codings, an investigation has shown that a number of "errors" and inconsistencies have been introduced by using CASOC in fully-automated mode. Errors and inconsistencies are present in all forms of coding - whether undertaken by coder, or machine, or some combination of both - but, funding has now been obtained to permit the re-CASOC all NCDS5 occupation information using full operator intervention so as to minimise problems with this aspect of NCD5 data.

In the meantime, work has already been completed on the re-CASOCing in this way of details of the "Cohort Member's Current/Last Job" as reported in the **NCDS5 Cohort Member Interview**. This re-CASOCed data been provisionally set up as an SPSS system file in order that it can be evaluated by researchers. Ultimately, this revised data will be included on the NCDS1-5 SIR data base.

The re-coding was undertaken by Laurence Letchford, formerly NCDS DP Manager, and the data is available to users on application to the NCDS User Support Group. Any problems or queries concerning this data should be reported to the them.

### Impact of re-coding

A preliminary comparison the re-CASOCed data and the existing NCDS5 CASOC data has been undertaken.

Tables 1 and 2 below summarise the differences between the existing NCDS5 coding of Cohort Member's current/last job and recoding undertaken by Laurie Letchford. Initial coding was achieved using CASOC in fully-automated mode. The recoding employed CASOC with full operator intervention - codes allocated by the software were reviewed and confirmed or modified as necessary.

Table 1 shows, for each of the classifications provided by CASOC (and the associated utility programs), the percentage of cases for which modified data are now available.

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As might be expected, the smaller the number of categories in a classification scheme, the lesser the likelihood that recoding will result in a re-classification.

The effect of the recoding of occupation data will vary for each case. There are some 27 separate classifications provided by CASOC, but only for 11 percent of cases are all of these changed by the recoding. Table 2 shows that data for just under 30 percent of cases were modified as a result of the recoding and indicates the number of classifications involved.

**Availability of data**

As noted above, the re-CASOCed data for the "Cohort Member's Current/Last Job" have been set up as an SPSS system file. A summary of the contents of the dataset is given in Table 3 below. Additional details are given in the Appendix.

The dataset is available to researchers on application to the NCDS User Support Group.

Please note, variable names have been chosen to parallel those allocated to the original CASOC data set for cohort member current/last job.

Ultimately, this revised data set will be included on the NCDS1-5 SIR Data Base.
